FINISHED SIZE: 48" X 36"

## **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

84 5" charm squares (2 packets) 1/2 yard racetrack gray 1½ yards backing fabric Fabric for binding

## **CUTTING**

**PIECING** 

From the gray, cut two 4 ½-inch width-offabric strips, then subcut into 18 4 1/2-inch squares.

Cut six 5-inch gray squares

Put six 5-inch gray squares to-

gether with six charm squares,

right sides facing, using dif-

ferent fabrics for each of the

charms. Draw a diagonal line

from one corner to the other.

will give you 12 half-gray/half-

Make 78

Trim each block to get rid of the extra fabric at the corners.

## **ASSEMBLY**

The quilt is 12 blocks across by 9 blocks down. See the diagram above for placement. With the exception of the half-gray/half-charm blocks, the orientation doesn't matter. Be careful with rows 2-3 and rows 7-8 to make sure that the racetrack goes in the right direction. Other than that, mix it up and have fun!

With the remaining 78 charm squares, repeat this process. Put two squares together, right sides facing. Aim for contrast between the squares. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to the other. Sew a scant quarter-inch seam on both sides of the lines, then cut along the line. Press toward the darker fabric.
